PAYMENT OPTIONS

In 2019, one annual account will be issued and the following payment options are available:

OPTION 1	One annual payment Fees due by the second Friday of Term 1	Single Instalment
OPTION 2	Two Semester payments Fees due second Friday of Terms 1 and 3	Two Instalments
OPTION 3	Four Term payments Fees due second Friday of Terms 1, 2, 3 and 4	Four Instalments
OPTION 4	Monthly payments February through to November	Ten Instalments

OPTION 5	Fortnightly payments February through to November	Twenty Instalments
OPTION 6	Weekly payments February through to November	Forty Instalments

PERIODICAL STATEMENTS

Once a term, each family will receive a statement, via email, detailing the status of their account.

OPTIONAL PROGRAMS

Tours – Sporting, Cultural, Academic: Payment of all tuition and fee accounts **must be up-to-date** at all times before a student's application for involvement in one of these programs will be considered.

SECONDARY ASSISTANCE SCHEME

The State Education Department offers a Secondary Assistance Scheme for the holders of a Centrelink Health Care Card, Pensioner Concession Card or Veteran Affairs Pensioner Concession Card. Application forms are available from Administration, and some conditions do apply. Closing date is mid-April 2019.

ABSENCE FROM THE COLLEGE

No reduction of fees will be made on account of an absence from the College, for whatever reason, as the cost incurred in operating the College are not lessened by the absence of individual students.

LATE PAYMENT OF FEES

Parents/Guardians who are unable to pay fees by the due date must apply to the Business Manager for an extension of payment. In the event that fees are four (4) weeks overdue the Principals reserve the right to cancel a student's enrolment. The College reserves the right to engage debt collectors and or initiate legal action to recover unpaid fees and charges. All associated debt collection costs incurred by the College will be added to the respective family's account.

FINANCIAL HARDSHIP

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

It is a condition of enrolment that one full term's notice of withdrawal of a student is given in writing. In the event that such notice is not given, a full term's tuition fee may apply

INSURANCE

The College has a Student Accident Insurance Policy covering all enrolled students. Insurance is for College based activities only, including transport to and from external College events. Parents are advised to have comprehensive (24 hours per day) private health insurance in addition.
