

FUTSAL ACADEMY AT MBC

The Futsal Academy Program now in its second year. Our vision is to establish a specialist program where students will develop into skillful and creative Futsal players through professional coaching whilst also cultivating a culture of character, commitment, teamwork and hard-work.

Players will be trained by coaches from Soccer De Brazil Academy through tailored sessions according to students' skill level, with the primary focus on development. Players will enter into the Academy via one of two pathways: the Academy Squad or the Academy Development Squad. Players will be individually assessed by SDB coaches through the process, where they will then be placed on a pathway.

WHAT IS FUTSAL?

Futsal is the FIFA-recognised form of small-sided indoor football (the word is a contraction of the Spanish 'fútbol sala'). It is played between two teams which each have five players on the court at any one time with rolling substitutes, and a smaller ball than soccer that is harder and less bouncy. The small amount of space means players must have great technical skills. The game is a high-intensity, fast-paced, dynamic, non-violent and enjoyable 5-a-side version of football that caters for both male and female participants. It is a professional sport in its own right with national and international championships, even though in many spheres it is considered a development tool for 11-a-side football.





WHO IS SOCCER DE BRAZIL?

Soccer de Brazil (SDB) has been raising the quality of football players in Australia for over 10 years. They are an elite Brazilian football academy that provides professional coaching to juniors, including preschool football training. They are at the forefront of evolving young players into masters of the sport, a pioneering force that is putting Australia on the map, for what is said to be 'the world game'.

SDB is one of the largest football academies in Australia operating in three different states. The WA Academy has been involved in training players at school level in both Futsal and Football. The SDB Futsal Academy is run by professional coaches who are equipped to mentor, train, mentally prepare, and inspire to create the best futsal players in the modern game. SDB coaches are passionate about youth development and injecting flair into the game.

PROGRAM DETAILS

The coaching sessions run once a week for 1 hour, over 10 weeks, breaking during the school holidays. Sessions resume in Week 1 at the start of every term.

Secondary students are encouraged to select the Futsal Specialist elective in Year 8, to further develop their skills and increase their opportunity for inter school selection. The training schedule is confirmed as of 2023. Please note, days are subject to change.

Once your registration is received, a place of offer will be emailed. *Please refer to the Terms & Conditions.

TRAINING SCHEDULE

Students are required to attend training sessions on their allocated days.
Following the training session, students will be dismissed to get changed into their College uniform prior to the commencement of the day's lessons.

ACADEMY KIT

Our approved academy kit will represent our College, partners and the program in a professional manner to the community. Every player will need to be attired in the kit for our coaching sessions. The kit can be sourced through our supplier, Ultra Football.

COST & FEES

The cost to students who wish to take part in the academy are as follows:

SDB COACHING FEES

Program Fees: \$200 per term | \$400 per semester.

All fees are payable before the start of each semester.

Fees are payable directly to the Colleges account department following an invoice.

ACADEMY KIT

Cost: \$110 (includes jersey with name, number and logos, shorts & socks) Orders and payments made directly to the supplier.

Please note; other fees may apply which are associated with various competitions and events throughout the year. All required information will be communicated ahead of time.

COMPETITIONS & TOURNAMENTS

Competitions and tournaments will be a complementary part of the development process for players in the academy program. The two major inter-school tournaments on the calendar are: The

Futsal WA School Titles and The SSWA Champion School Futsal.

The Futsal Academy looks to prepare players to be available for selection into these tournaments. Players can also nominate to presented the school in other domestic competitions during the year.

No interstate tours are planned at this point in time, but may be possible in the future.

Other competitions and tournaments may also become available during the year. All competition and tournament information and requirements will be emailed out ahead of time.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

The program fees in 2023 will be charged per semester, meaning a term in advance. SDB has applied a partnership discount of 20% to their normal coaching rates, as advertised on their website.

The semester fee of \$400.00 is payable before the commencement of Term 1 week 1 and Term 3 Week 1.

Invoices are payable directly to the college's account department or via online banking. (Please refer to invoice for details).

Semester 1 and 2 invoices will be emailed to the registered email address on file. Please make sure we have an up-to-date email address to avoid lapsing on invoices. The College takes no responsibility for missed invoices once they have been emailed.

Spots in the MBC Futsal Academy are offered via email and deemed accepted once the invoice is paid in full.

Players will be deemed ineligible to train where invoices have not been paid. It is assumed, all players will continue with their registrations after each term break. If a parent wishes to terminate their child's registration, they may do so by written notification to the Sports Coordinator at futsalacademy@mbc.wa.edu.au.

Written notification must be received seven (7) days before the commencement of each term. A full refund of any program fees for the term paid in advance will be applied if the written notification is received within the seven (7) day allowance.

Extenuating circumstances requiring termination outside of the seven (7) days will need to be directed to the Sports Coordinator at futsalacademy@mbc.wa.edu.au and will be dealt with on a discretion case basis.

Registrations terminate at the end of each schooling year and any player wishing to continue into the new year must submit a new registration (Accessible through the school's website).

Registrations for 2023 will not be accepted where 2022 invoices have not been paid in full.

Allocated Jersey numbers will be reserved for each player for one (1) year at the termination of their registration. Numbers will come back into circulation after the year reservation period.

Associated uniform and competition fees are non-refundable.
